Item 1. Welcomes/Apologies/Matters Arising

Item 2. Minutes of the last Meeting

Decision: The draft Minutes of the Last Meeting were agreed as an accurate record.

Item 3. Reminder on Conflicting Interests

Discussion: The Secretary gave a routine reminder on the matter of reporting conflicts of interest. No Conflicts of Interest of significance were noted.

Item 4. Family Support and Mentoring

Discussion: A lengthy discussion took place considering the objections that had been raised to the methodology of the project at the previous meeting.

6.1: West End Online Directory: The Secretary gave an update, overview and website walkthrough of the status of this community directory project, which is currently still in Beta testing but hopes to be launched by December 2024.

6.2: Online Game: The Development Worker gave an update of the status of the online game project. Several game options have been made and can be badged to WEM/the West End. The game options will be shared for future decision. **Action:** The Secretary to share the links to the online game options to partners.

6.3: Children's Environment Project: Yvon gave an update on recent developments with the project, which is progressing well. West End Primary school have not been engaged as would be liked. We are still awaiting draft designs from Groundwork. Next meeting will be on 16th May. Decision: Yvon will make a final visit to engage West End Primary school when draft designs are received.

6.4: Digital Exclusion Project: The Development Worker will be inviting representatives of Lancaster & Morecambe College to the June meeting to get an update.

6.5: Other Projects: The partners asked if we could get an update on the recently completed HEAT project with Green Rose.
